

High School Curriculum Grades 9-12

Williamsburg Christian Academy seeks to prepare students intellectually and spiritually for higher education. Students participate in a variety of rigorous academic offerings in math, science, English, world languages, technology, Honors, and AP courses. Daily Bible instruction, weekly chapels, and mentoring opportunities combine to build a strong foundation for the student to stand on after graduation. Students are encouraged to explore their individual gifts and talents by joining extracurricular activities, including team sports, or the cast of our school wide Spring Musical production.

Required community service emphasizes the importance of a servant's heart. At each grade level in high school, students are offered the opportunity to participate in short term mission trips over the spring break. The freshman and sophomore mission field is within the borders of the United States while Juniors and Seniors are given the opportunity to travel outside the United States to share the gospel.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS
